At our main facility brewers operate a 15bbl, 3 vessel, Premier Brew System, filling 15 and 30bbl fermenters. Packaging sees a mixture of 12oz, 16oz, specialty 500ml bottles, and 1/6 or 1/2bbl kegs. Our original location, and original 5bbl Premier Brew System operates on a more limited schedule for specialty draft only releases or barrel aging.
